PRESENTATION OF YOCODESOP

YOCODESOP (Youth Congress for Development and Social-Progress) is a non-profit association of solidarity law. Declared on 02/25/2020 in the Dowa District and published in the Official Journal on 03/10/2020

Target audience :

YOCODESOP's action is mainly aimed at young people, girls and women, regardless of their background.

Status:

YOCODESOP is a non-profit association. It wants to be apolitical, independent and non-denominational.

Internal functioning:

The association is essentially based on the action of volunteers. These are found at every level of decision and action. The association also entrusts the day-to-day management to a team of permanent staff.

Mission:

YOCODESOP's mission is to strengthen the capacities of young people to be aware, Critical Active and Solidarity through two lines of action: education for sustainable local development, vocational training and education through action.

ACHIEVEMENT ACTIVITIES

During this six (6) months Our actions on the ground True to our mission, our actions revolve around an axis which we deem necessary to the overall development of girls / boys and women education (Training) community development.

In this round, we have as always two activities that have preoccupied us during these six (6) months. To do this, our association was able to carry out training activities in tailoring and in English.

ACTIVITIES

1. Tailoring training



During the 6 months we recorded 75 pupils of which 52 students were women which represents 69.3% and 23 were men which represents 30.6%. As usual this total number are divided into two groups, there are those who study from 8h to 12h and the other group from 13h to 17h.

For this training, 69 students simply validly completed the six (6) month training including 49 women / girls and 20 men / boys (). For this figure we can boast was 92% follow-up which is for us a success.

2. Computer training



For this activity we recorded 64 highs including 21 women / girls and 43 men / boys, also as usual they are grouped into two one group, study it in the morning and the other group study in after-midday.

Future projects

- 1) We would like to organize an end of year fair bringing together the two training schools of our entity and await your suggestions to this effect.
- 2) We plan to launch a large project whose title is: Drinking water and sanitation for all, is a holistic and united development project, through sustainable management in the Dzaleka refugee camp.

This project consists of 5 different ends:

- Hand washing facility ; 350 hand-washers will be made and distributed to schools in Dzaleka camp
- The construction of the shop for the promotion of water treatment product
- Improvement of existing water points and good management of sanitation,
- Water supply ; 10 hand pumps will be built in the Camp
- Drinking water treatment
